RESOLVE in favor of the Farmington State Normal School
for furnishings and equipment for a dormitory.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated in
2 favor of the Farmington state normal school the sum of
3 ten thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred fourteen
4 such amount to be expended under the direction of the
5 board of trustees of the state normal schools for furnish-
6 ings and equipment for a dormitory at said school; pro-
7 vided, however, that said board of trustees may, at the dis-
8 cretion of the board, apply any of said amount toward
9 purposes of construction.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The amount called for in the accompanying resolve is for the purpose of providing furnishings and the necessary equipment for a dormitory. Provision is made by the terms of this resolve that a portion of this appropriation may, if so required, be used to meet additional expense of construction.
