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AN ACT to incorporate the Kingfield Chamber of Commerce.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. The Kingfield Chamber of Commerce, a vol-  
2 untary association existing at Kingfield for the promotion  
3 of the industry, commerce and public interests of the town  
4 of Kingfield and vicinity, is hereby constituted and declared  
5 to be a body politic and corporate under the name of King-  
6 field Chamber of Commerce, with the same by-laws now in  
7 force and with all the rights and privileges and powers and  
8 immunities of corporations organized under the first six  
9 sections of chapter fifty-seven of the Revised Statutes of  
10 this state.
