STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to incorporate the Kingfield Chamber of Commerce.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The Kingfield Chamber of Commerce, a vol2 untary association existing at Kingfield for the promotion
3 of the industry, commerce and public interests of the town
4 of Kingfield and vicinity, is hereby constituted and declared
5 to be a body politic and corporate under the name of King6 field Chamber of Commerce, with the same by-laws now in
7 force and with all the rights and privileges and powers and
8 immunities of corporations organized under the first six
9 sections of chapter fifty-seven of the Revised Statutes of
10 this state.
