STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to Prevent the use of the name of the State by Private or Semi-public Corporations or Associations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No charitable institution or association of a
2 private or of a semi-public nature, incorporated by special
3 act of the legislature or in conformity with section one
4 of chapter fifty-seven of the revised statutes, formed or
5 incorporated after this act becomes effective, shall use the
6 name of the state in its title.

Sect. 2. Any institution or association that violates the

2 provisions of this act shall, upon notice and complaint by
3 any person to the governor and council, and after hearing
4 had by that body, be held to have forfeited the right to any
5 appropriation from the state.
