IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

An Act to amend Chapter thirteen, of the Private and Special  
Laws of nineteen hundred and eleven, entitled "An Act to  
Create the Bingham Water District."

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Section eight of Chapter thirteen of the Private  
2 and Special Laws of nineteen hundred and eleven, is hereby  
3 amended by striking out all of said section eight, and insert-  
4 ing in place thereof the following:

'Sect. 8. The trustees of said Bingham Water District  
6 are hereby authorized, whenever they deem it necessary for  
7 the welfare of the district, or for the purpose of raising  
8 funds to defray the expense of furnishing water in said  
9 district for the purpose of fire protection, or for the pur-

10 pose of raising funds to be expended on repairs, alterations  
11 or additions to said district's water system, to levy a tax  
12 upon the legally taxable property within said district and  
13 under fire protection; such tax to be assessed in accordance  
14 with the provisions of Chapter nine of the Revised Stat-  
15 utes, and in accordance with the valuation of said property  
16 as rendered by the assessors of the town of Bingham. All  
17 the provisions of said chapter nine, which are applicable,  
18 are hereby made to apply to said Bingham Water District  
19 for the above mentioned purposes, except that the trustees  
20 of said water district shall levy any tax that may become  
21 necessary, and shall issue a warrant for its collection to the  
22 treasurer of said Bingham Water District, he to collect the  
23 same, and to have the same powers and liabilities, so far as  
24 the collection of any tax that may be assessed in accordance  
25 with this act, as tax collectors of cities and towns. The pro-  
26 visions of chapter ten, of the Revised Statutes, which are  
27 applicable, are hereby made to apply to the Bingham Water  
28 District for the purposes above mentioned. There shall be  
29 a lien upon the taxable property, above mentioned, for any  
30 tax that may be levied by said Bingham Water District,  
31 through its trustees, as is provided in said chapters nine and  
32 ten, except that such lien shall be subject to the lien of said  
33 town of Bingham for the taxes legally assessed upon said  
34 property by said town.'
