STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

RESOLVE, for Military Pensions.

Resolved, That the sum of six thousand dollars be and is
2 hereby appropriated for the payment of military pensions
3 as provided by various Resolves of the Legislature, for the
4 year nineteen hundred and thirteen, and six thousand dollars
5 for the year nineteen hundred and fourteen.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Legislature of nineteen hundred and eleven appropriated the sum of forty-five hundred dollars for each of the years nineteen hundred and eleven and nineteen hundred and twelve. This sum was barely sufficient to pay the Military Pensions as allowed by Legislature. This session of the Legislature have added quite a number to the list of those receiving military pensions. In order that these pensions may be paid, it is absolutely necessary that the sum asked for in this Resolve should be appropriated.
