#### STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, for State Pensions.

Resolved, That the sum of one hundred and eighteen thou-

- 2 sand dollars be and is hereby appropriated to provide for
- 3 State pensions for invalid soldiers and sailors, their widows
- 4 and orphans, and the dependent children, parents and sisters
- 5 of deceased soldiers and sailors eligible thereto under exist-
- 6 ing law, for the year nineteen hundred and thirteen and one
- 7 hundred and eighteen thousand dollars for the year nineteen
- 8 hundred and fourteen.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The action of the Legislature in adding to the number of those eligible to receive state pensions, that is, the widows of the soldiers of the War with Spain, and the natural increase of those asking state pension by reason of age and infirmity, make an increase of the amount appropriated by previous Legislatures absolutely necessary, in order that reasonable relief may be furnished to the many needy and worthy applicants.
