AN ACT to regulate the use of Buildings as Slaughter Houses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The use of any building, situated in the center
2 of an area of five hundred foot radius which contains any
3 church, schoolhouse, or group of five or more dwellings,
4 as a slaughter house, is a common nuisance within the mean-
5 ing of Revised Statutes, chapter twenty-two, section twelve.
6 Provided, however, that such building may be so used with
7 the written consent of all persons and corporations affected
8 thereby within such area. Said written consent shall
9 terminate with each calendar year.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates the provisions of this act shall
2 be punished by fine not exceeding twenty-five dollars for
3 each offence.
