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STATE OF MAINE

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

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AN ACT relating to the organization of corporations under  
private and special laws.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. No corporation created by special act of the  
2 legislature, municipal corporations excepted, shall carry on  
3 any business whatsoever, before filing in the office of the  
4 secretary of state the certificate of organization provided by  
5 section three of chapter forty-seven of the Revised Statutes.

Sect. 2. Whoever, whether the persons named in the act  
2 of the legislature or others, conducts and carries on any  
3 business whatsoever in the name of such corporation before

4 filing said certificate shall be personally and individually  
5 liable for all contracts and debts of said corporation con-  
6 tracted prior to the filing of said certificate.

Sect. 3. The provisions of this act shall apply to all per-  
2 sons granted special rights and privileges by act of the Leg-  
3 islature.
