STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT relating to the organization of corporations under private and special laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. No corporation created by special act of the

- 2 legislature, municipal corporations excepted, shall carry on
- 3 any business whatsoever, before filing in the office of the
- 4 secretary of state the certificate of organization provided by
- ${\mathfrak z}$ section three of chapter forty-seven of the Revised Statutes.

Sect. 2. Whoever, whether the persons named in the act

- 2 of the legislature or others, conducts and carries on any
- 3 business whatsoever in the name of such corporation before

- 4 filing said certificate shall be personally and individually
- 5 liable for all contracts and debts of said corporation con-
- 6 tracted prior to the filing of said certificate.
- Sect. 3. The provisions of this act shall apply to all per-2 sons granted special rights and privileges by act of the Leg-3 islature.
