STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend Section 93 of Chapter 83 of the Revised
Statutes, relating to the time in which actions shall be
brought.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section ninety-three of chapter eighty-three of
2 the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by substituting in
3 the second line of said section the word 'ten' for "twenty"
4 and adding to said section the following words: 'Providing
5 that said limitation of ten years shall not apply to actions
6 on contracts made before August 1st, 1913,' so that said
7 section shall read as follows:

'Sect. 93. Personal actions on any contract not otherwise
9 limited shall be brought within ten years after the cause of
10 action accrues, provided that said limitation of ten years
11 shall not apply to actions on contracts made before August
12 1st, 1913.'
