### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT relating to the Fort Kent Electric Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Fort Kent Electric Company, a corporation

- 2 organized by law and located at Fort Kent in the county
- 3 of Aroostook and state of Maine, is hereby authorized to
- 4 make, generate, sell, distribute and supply gas or electricity,
- 5 or both, for lighting, heating, manufacturing or mechanical
- 6 purposes, in the town of Fort Kent, in the county of Aroos-
- 7 took, and also in the plantations of Allagash, St. Francis,
- 8 St. John, Wallagrass and Eagle Lake, all in said county of
- 9 Aroostook.

Said town of Fort Kent, or any village corpo-2 ration within the limits of said town of Fort Kent, at any 3 time within (10) ten years after the opening for use and 4 service of the electric light system constructed by said Fort 5 Kent Electric Company, as herein authorized, and after a 6 vote in a legal meeting of said town or of said village cor-7 poration to that effect has been passed, shall have the right 8 to purchase, and by this act said company is required to sell 9 said electric system, together with the franchises of said to company relating thereto, to said town, or to said village II corporation, for such price as may be agreed upon by said 12 town or village corporation, and said company. And should 13 said parties be unable to agree upon the amount to be paid 14 therefor, the same shall be determined by a commission con-15 sisting of three competent and disinterested men, one of 16 whom shall be selected by said company, one by said town 17 of Fort Kent or by said village corporation, and the third 18 shall be selected by the chief justice of the supreme judicial 19 court of Maine upon petition of either said company or said 20 town or village corporation. The award of said commis-21 sioners, not less than cost, shall be binding upon said com-22 pany and upon said town or village corporation, and said 23 town or village corporation shall pay the amount of said 24 award for said electric system and franchises within ninety 25 days from the date when such award shall be rendered. The 26 costs of said commission shall be borne equally by said com-27 pany and said town or village corporation.

Sect. 3. In case of the purchase of said electric system 2 as herein provided, said town or village corporation may 3 pay the purchase price from moneys raised by taxation, or 4 by the issuance of bonds, and said town or village corporation, for the purposes herein provided, is hereby expressly 6 authorized and empowered to issue the bonds of said town 7 or village corporation in accordance with the provisions of 8 law which now exist or may exist at the time of said purgo chase.
