STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Rejected papers, a valuable part of the records of the legislature are finally filed in the office of the Secretary of the Senate. These papers have been kept in a set of pasteboard boxes on wooden shelves, offering no protection against fire or thieves.

The sum asked for will provide cases enough to file the papers that have accumulated since 1903, together with those that will be left after the present session.
