IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to prohibit the use of common drinking cups.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The use of the common drinking cup or recep-
2 tacle for drinking in any public place, vehicle or building is
3 prohibited except in accordance with rules and regulations
4 adopted by the State Board of Health, which the State Board
5 of Health is hereby authorized and directed to adopt and
6 promulgate before September 1st, 1913, for the purpose of
7 preventing the spread of communicable diseases by use of
8 such cup or receptacle.

Sect. 2. Any person, firm, corporation or association who

2 violates section 1 of this act or any rule or regulation of the
3 State Board of Health made in pursuance thereof, shall be
4 guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more
5 than twenty-five dollars.
