STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend Section two of Chapter two hundred fifty of the Public Laws of one thousand nine hundred and nine, relating to the payment of fees accruing to State Institutions and Departments.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section two of chapter two hundred and fifty
2 of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and nine is hereby
3 amended, by substituting for said section two the following:

'Sect. 2. All fees, or other income which may become due
5 and payable to any institution or department of the state,
6 from whatever source accruing, shall be paid by the official

7 receiving the same directly to the treasurer of state and cred-
8 ited, as received by him, to the appropriation of the institu-
9 tion or department to which it accrues. A detailed state-
10 ment of the source and amount of such fees or such income
11 shall be filed with the state auditor at the time such fees or
12 income are paid to the treasurer of state and such payment
13 shall be made and such statement thereof shall be filed at
14 the end of each calendar month.

‘All bills of any institution or department of the state shall
16 be paid by the treasurer of the state to whom due and pay-
17 able, on warrant approved by the governor and council,
18 after proper vouchers therefor have been approved by the
19 proper official of the institution or department contracting
20 the same, and audited by the state auditor.’

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this
2 act are hereby repealed.
