STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT concerning a New England Railroad Conference.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The governor, by and with the advice and
2 consent of the council, shall appoint two citizens of this
3 state as members of a New England railroad conference,
4 to act in conjunction with the appointees of the governors
5 of the other New England states, to consider and report
6 on the best methods of developing and operating the New
7 England railroad systems.

Sect. 2. Said commissioners shall serve without pay but
2 shall receive actual necessary expenses while engaged in
3 the work of the commission.

Sect. 3. The sum of five hundred dollars is hereby appro-
2 priated towards defraying the general clerical expenses at-
3 tending the meetings of the conference.
