STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, to establish a State Nursery, to encourage the reforesting of the waste lands of the State of Maine.

Resolved, That the sum of one thousand dollars be and 2 hereby is appropriated for the year nineteen hundred and 3 thirteen and the sum of one thousand dollars for the year 4 nineteen hundred and fourteen, to be expended by the For-5 est Commissioner for the purpose of establishing a State 6 forest nursery in connection with the school of forestry, to 7 supply forest tree seedlings at a cost of production for use 8 in planting lands in the State of Maine.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Applications are constantly being received by the State Forestry Department from citizens of the State, for planting stock. The object of establishing a nursery would be to supply citizens of Maine with forest tree seedlings suitable for planting on waste and cut over lands, at a cost of production. The probable cost would be about as follows:

2 acres of land (already secured at the University

of Maine)	No cost

Preparation of seed beds	75 00
Protection frames for seed beds	200 00
Equipment for watering seedlings	550 00
