SENATE AMENDMENT "D 1" TO SENATE DOCU-MENT NO. 453.

Amend Section 39 by striking out the words "except where 2 the purpose of such connection is primarily to secure the 3 transmission of local messages or conversations between 4 points within the same city or town" in the 14th, 15th, 16th 5 and 17th lines and inserting in the place thereof the words 6 'between different localities which cannot be communicated 7 with or reached by the lines of either company alone'.
