SENATE AMENDMENT "E 1" TO SENATE DOCU-MENT NO. 453.

Senate Document No. 453 is hereby amended by striking 2 out all of Section 9 and inserting in the place thereof the 3 following:

'Sect. 9. The term "public utility" as used in this act shall 5 mean and embrace every individual, association of individ-6 uals, corporation, company, city, town, village, municipal or 7 quasi-municipal corporation, their lessees, trustees or re-8 ceivers that now or hereafter may own, operate, manage or

9 control any boat or vessel on inland waters or railroad, either

operated for freight business or passenger business or both, whether propelled by steam or otherwise; or may conduct a parlor, sleeping, heating or refrigerator car business; or that may conduct an express business or be engaged in the conveyance of telephone or telegraph messages or the protocological duction, transmission, delivery or furnishing of gas, electricity, heat, light, water or power, to the public.'
