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SENATE AMENDMENT "L 1" TO SENATE DOCU-  
MENT NO. 453.

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Amend Section 5 by striking out the words "or any person  
2 or persons employed by the commission for that purpose"  
3 in the first, second and third lines; also by striking out the  
4 sentence "any person other than one of said commissioners  
5 who shall make such demand shall produce his authority to  
6 make such inspection" in the sixth, seventh and eighth lines:  
7 also by striking out the sentence "Such person or persons so  
8 employed shall not directly or indirectly divulge any informa-  
9 tion so derived to any one except to the commission or under

10 direction of the commission” in the eighth, ninth, tenth and  
11 eleventh lines and inserting in the place thereof ‘Any person  
12 or persons employed by the commission shall not directly or  
13 indirectly divulge any information derived by them through  
14 their employment to any one except to the commission or  
15 under the direction of the commission’.
