STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to authorize the city of Lewiston to issue its bonds to the amount of one hundred thousand dollars to pay its bonds now outstanding and maturing in the year one thousand nine hundred and thirteen.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. To meet its bonds now outstanding and maturing in the year one thousand nine hundred and thirteen, the city of Lewiston is authorized to issue bonds to an amount not exceeding one hundred thousand dollars, payable at a period or periods, not exceeding thirty years after the date thereof, and bearing interest at a rate not exceeding four

7 per cent per annum, payable semi-annually. Said bonds
8 shall be issued under the seal of the city and shall be signed
9 by the mayor and treasurer of the city, and the coupons at-
10 tached to said bonds shall have the printed or lithographed
11 signatures of the city treasurer.
