STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to authorize Sheriffs and Jailers of the several counties in their discretion to furnish money and transportation to prisoners about to be discharged from jail.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. The sheriffs of the several counties in the state
2 may in their discretion give a prisoner, about to be dis3 charged from jail, over which the said several sheriffs have
4 custody, a sum of money not exceeding two dollars, and
5 wearing apparel not exceeding the value of ten dollars, and
6 may also furnish said discharged prisoner a railroad ticket.
7 non-transferable, to any place, the fare to which does not
8 exceed the sum of eight dollars.

Sect. 2. The money so paid out and expended by said 2 sheriff or jailer shall be repaid to him out of the county 3 treasury, after the bill has been audited and the amount 4 found correct by the county commissioners.
