STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend Section fifteen of Chapter fifteen of the Revised Statutes, as amended, relating to the approval of school accounts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. Section fifteen of chapter fifteen of the Re2 vised Statutes as amended by chapter forty-eight of the
3 Public Laws of nineteen hundred and five is hereby further
4 amended by inserting after the word "items" in the fifth

- 5 line thereof the words 'said bill of items having first been 6 approved by a majority of the members of the superintend-
- 7 ing school committee and certified by the superintendent of

8 schools,' so that said section when amended shall read as 9 follows:

'Sect. 15. No money appropriated by law for the public 11 schools shall be paid from the treasury of any town, except 11 upon written order of the municipal officers; and no such 12 order shall be drawn by said officers except upon presenta-13 tion of a properly avouched bill of items, said bill of items 14 having first been approved by a majority of the members 15 of the superintending school committee and certified by the 16 superintendent of schools. The unexpended balance of all 17 moneys raised by towns, or received from the state, for the 18 payment of wages and board of teachers, fuel, janitors' 19 services, conveyance or tuition and board of scholars, shall 20 be credited to the school resources for the year following 21 that in which said unexpended balance occurred. This 22 clause, relating to unexpended balance, shall not apply to 23 cities.'
