STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Commissioners of Pharmacy.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the

- 2 sum of one thousand five hundred dollars, for the year nine-
- 3 teen hundred and thirteen, and one thousand five hundred
- 4 dollars for the year nineteen hundred and fourteen, for the
- 5 use of the commissioners of pharmacy.

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STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The expense of the Pharmacy Board is about \$2000 per annum. There is an income from examinations of about \$500. This balance of \$1500 called for is to meet a deficiency caused by investigations and prosecutions of violators of the law. Also for a deficiency in not having enough revenue from new applicants to recompense the Board for their expenses. There are three members of the Board appointed by the Governor.
