STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Industrial School for Girls at
Hallowell for Medical Examination and Treatment with
Supplies.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sums of one thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred
3 thirteen and five hundred dollars for the year nineteen hun-
4 dred fourteen to be expended under the direction of the
5 trustees of juvenile institutions for the purpose of supply-
6 ing medical examination and treatment with supplies for
7 the inmates of the Maine Industrial School for Girls at
8 Hallowell.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This appropriation is requested for the purpose of purchasing equipment and supplies for the proper and necessary examination and treatment of girls committed to the Industrial School and to provide for the payment of the services of a physician or physicians or nurses for such examination and treatment. There is no suitable room for the isolation of contagious cases and this appropriation would make possible fitting up one or two rooms for hospital purposes.
