STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE relating to the Penobscot Tribe of Indians.

Whereas, the report of the state auditor for the years 1907 and 1908 shows that through errors in the charging up of interest and in proper crediting of other items, the books of the state treasurer on December 31st, 1908, did not show the correct amount in the hands of the state held in trust for the benefit of the Penobscot Tribe of Indians; that the amount in said fund as it appeared on the books of the treasurer on said December 31st, was \$72,328.48, while according to said auditor's report the correct amount in the hands of the state in said fund was \$89,592.44, and

Whereas, the correct amount in the hands of the state in said trust fund on the 1st day of January, 1913, was \$88,092.44

and the books of the state treasurer show as credited to said trust fund only \$72,328.48;

Resolved, That the state treasurer and state auditor be 2 and they are hereby authorized and directed to carry to the 3 credit of the said Penobscot Tribe of Indians trust fund 4 on the proper books of account of the state treasurer the 5 sum of \$15,763.96, so that the correct amount of said fund 6 shall appear on the books of the state treasurer as of Jan-7 uary 1st, 1913, to wit: the sum of \$88,092.44.
