STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of Edward W. Murphy for expenses of Committee appointed by Seventy-fifth Legislature to investigate methods of distributing State School Funds (accompanied by statement of facts).

Resolved, That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to 2 be paid to Edward W. Murphy the sum of four hundred 3 and nineteen dollars and fifty-one cents for expenses of 4 the special committee appointed by the Seventy-fifth Legis-5 lature to investigate methods of distributing state school 6 funds.

STATEMENT OF FACTS TO ACCOMPANY RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF EDWARD W. MURPHY.

The Seventy-fifth Legislature appointed a special committee, consisting of two on the part of the Senate and three on the part of the House, to investigate the present and proposed methods of distribution of state school funds and report to this Legislature. The committee made a thorough investigation and a detailed report which is printed as Senate Document Number 121. This document includes, in addition to the general report and recommendations, three tables showing the sources of school funds in each city and town in the State and the effect in each city and town of each of the three proposed methods of distribution of State school funds in comparison with the present method. The preparation of these tables involved nearly twenty-five thousand separate computations and in addition to the investigations made, required an enormous amount of clerical work. Except for the valuable assistance rendered the committee by Superintendent Smith, Assistant Superintendent Allan and the clerks in the office of their department, the investigation would have been very much more expensive. The items of the expenses included in the resolve are as follows:
