SENATE AMENDMENT "A" TO SENATE DOCUMENT NO. 575.

Amend Clause 2 of Section 1 by adding thereto the follow-2 ing words: (e) 'laborers employed in the cutting, hauling, 3 yarding or driving of logs or lumber, or any laborer in the 4 woods or on the drives', so that said clause of section 1 shall 5 read as follows:

II. "Employee" shall include every person in the service 7 of another under contract of hire, express or implied, oral 8 or written, except (a) farm laborers, (b) domestic sergivants, (c) persons whose employment by corporations, part-

10 nerships and natural persons is not in the usual course of 11 the trade, business, profession or occupation of their em12 ployers, (d) officials of the state, counties, cities, towns or 13 water districts, (e) laborers employed in the cutting, haul14 ing, yarding or driving of logs or lumber, or any laborer in 15 the woods or on the drives.
