SENATE AMENDMENT "E" TO SENATE DOCUMENT NO. 575.

Amend section II of Senate Document No. 575 by strik-2 ing out lines I to 24 inclusive and inserting in place thereof 3 the following:

'Sect. 11. A commission is hereby created to be known 5 as the Industrial Accident Commission of the State of 6 Maine, and it shall consist of three members, which com-7 mission shall be vested with and possessed of all the powers 8 and duties specified in this act and who shall be severally 9 sworn to the faithful performance of their duties and shall 10 hold office for the term of three years or until their suc-

11 cessors respectively shall be appointed and qualified to act. 12 Within ten days after this act becomes law the governor 13 by and with the advice and consent of the council shall ap-14 point three such persons to be members of the Industrial 15 Accident Commission of Maine; one to hold office for one 16 year, one to hold office for two years and a chairman to 17 hold office for three years, and any member of said com-18 mission for wilful neglect of duty or for malfeasance in 19 office may after notice and hearing be removed from office 20 by the governor and council. In case of a vacancy occur-21 ring through death, resignation or removal the governor 22 shall with the advice and consent of the council appoint a 23 successor for the term of three years subject to removal, 24 as aforesaid. Such chairman shall receive a salary of \$2500 25 per year and the other members of the commission shall 26 receive a salary of \$1500 per year. The members of said 27 commission shall also receive their traveling expenses actu-28 ally and necessarily incurred in the performance of their 29 duties.'
