RESOLVE appropriating money to reimburse Charles M. Conant, Chairman of the Committee on Ways and Bridges, for certain Committee expenses.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the

- 2 sum of thirty-one dollars and fifty-five cents to be paid to
- 3 Charles M. Conant of Winterport, chairman of the joint
- 4 standing committee on ways and bridges, to reimburse him
- 5 for money expended for transportation of the members of
- 6 the committee to Old Town and return.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The Committee on Ways and Bridges visited the site of the bridge at Old Town, for which an appropriation was asked, for the purpose of determining whether such appropriation was necessary. The resolve simply provides for the reimbursement of the committee chairman for the money expended in making the trip.
