STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of the Superintendent of Public Buildings, to provide for a rail in the Senate Chamber.

Resolved, 'That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of three hundred and fifty dollars to be expended by 3 the superintendent of public buildings for the installation 4 of a suitable rail behind the seats in the Senate Chamber. * .

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The superintendent after consultation with several members of the Senate has submitted the matter to a competent contractor and found that a suitable rail in harmony with the furnishings of the Senate Chamber with brass chains and appropriate fixtures would cost not to exceed the sum mentioned in the resolve.
