STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE to provide for indexing House and Senate Papers
in Senate Office, for Session of 1913.

*Resolved, That the sum of one hundred dollars be and
2 hereby is appropriated to be paid to the secretary of the
3 Senate for indexing the House and Senate papers for the
4 Legislative session of one thousand nine hundred and thir-
5 teen.*

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The official papers in connection with every matter considered by the Legislature, which have not resulted in the enactment of law, are filed in the office of the Secretary of the Senate and are indexed, for the use of the general public. The amount that has always been appropriated is one hundred dollars.
