STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE to provide for re-indexing House and Senate

Papers now on file in the Senate Office.

Resolved, That the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars

- 2 be and hereby is appropriated to be paid to the secretary
- 3 of the Senate for re-indexing the House and Senate papers
- 4 in the office of the secretary, which have accumulated since
- 5 1903, but not including the papers of the present legislature.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The House and Senate papers which have been accumulating in the Senate Office for the last ten years have not only outgrown the present filing facilities, but they have become so badly mixed, due to moving incident to the remodelling of the State House and constant handling without supervision, that it is now very difficult to find any particular paper. This causes serious inconvenience and delay to the public, who have a right to the use of the papers. An appropriation has already been approved by the Finance Committee for steel cases to protect these papers.
