STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend Chapter two hundred fifty-six of the Private and Special Laws of the year one thousand nine hundred and seven, in relation to the Cumberland County Power and Light Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. Section three of chapter two hundred fifty-six

of the Private and Special Laws of eighteen hundred and
ninety-seven is hereby amended by striking out the word

five" in the third line of said section and inserting the word

ten' in place thereof, so that said section as amended shall
read as follows:

'Sect. 3. The capital stock of said corporation shall not 8 be less than two hundred and fifty thousand dollars nor 9 more than ten million dollars, as the stockholders shall from 10 time to time determine, and shall be divided into shares of 11 one hundred dollars each.'
