STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTEEN.

AN ACT to amend Chapter one hundred and ninety-three of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and nine, creating the Maine Forestry District and providing for protection against forest fires therein.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter one hundred ninety-three of the Pub2 lic Laws of nineteen hundred nine is hereby amended by
3 inserting as section fourteen, the following:

'Sect. 14. Any incorporated town or organized plantation 5 adoining any part of the Maine Forestry District may by 6 vote at any meeting of its inhabitants duly called and held, 8 the provisions of this act. A copy of such vote certified by 9 the town clerk or plantation assessors, shall be forwarded 10 forthwith to the state treasurer and from the time of the 11 filing of such certified copy of said vote in the office of the 12 state treasurer and state forest commissioner, the town or 13 plantation so voting shall be and continue a part of said 14 Forestry District. All incorporated towns or organized 15 plantations which by and under the provisions of this act 16 or any act hereafter to be passed shall be and become a part 17 of said Maine Forestry District and all officers of such town 18 or plantation shall be and are exempt from the duties and 19 obligations imposed by sections fifty-two and fifty-six of 20 chapter seven of the Revised Statutes of Maine.'

Sect. 2. Sections fourteen and fifteen of said chapter one 2 hundred ninety-three are re-numbered respectively sections 3 fifteen and sixteen.
