STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of Clerk and Stenographer to Committee
on Ways and Bridges.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated to be
2 paid to H. P. Hawes for services as clerk to committee on
3 Ways and Bridges, the sum of three hundred dollars
4 (\$300); and to C. A. Gage, stenographer to same commit-
5 tee, the sum of fifty dollars (\$50).

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

To the Committee on Ways and Bridges has been referred a greater number of bills and resolves than ever before has been presented to a similar committee. This has been due in part to the fact that many bills and resolves formerly referred to Committee on State Lands and State Roads have been considered by this committee. Also, the unusual labor incident to the presentation of the "Act to establish a State Highway Commission and provide for an issue of State Highway Bonds," occupied much time. Practically all measures reported favorably have been redrafted by the clerk and it is the unanimous verdict of the committee that the sums named in the resolve for the services of the clerk and stenographer are extremely reasonable.
