STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE in favor of Clerk, Stenographer and Messenger to the Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of five hundred dollars to be paid to E. B. Mallet for 3 services as clerk to the Committee on Appropriations and 4 Financial Affairs; one hundred and twenty-five dollars to 5 be paid to Elizabeth Jacobs for services as stenographer; 6 seventy-five dollars to be paid Ralph R. Baker for services 7 as messenger; eight dollars to be paid Harold Archibald for 8 rental of typewriter.
