STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to authorize the Kennebec Lumber Company to maintain piers and booms in the Kennebec River above the Augusta dam.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. The Kennebec Lumber Company is hereby authorized and empowered to locate and maintain on the easterly side of the Kennebec River above the Augusta dam,
between the south line of land of Joseph Harwood in Augusta and the sorting gap of the Samuel D. Warren sorting
boom, so called, piers, buoys and booms for the purpose of
holding, storing and sorting logs and other lumber coming

8 down the river and destined for use or manufacture by said9 Kennebec Lumber Company.

Sect. 2. Said piers, buoys and booms shall be so con2 structed as not to impede the use of navigation on said river,
3 and not to occasion any unreasonable delay or obstruction
4 in the driving of any logs or lumber owned by other parties.
