AN ACT to amend Section 72 of Chapter 4 of Revised Stat-  
utes of Maine relating to Firemen's Memorial Sunday.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Section 72 of Chapter 4 of the Revised Stat-  
utes is hereby amended by adding after the words, "Memo-  
rial Day," the words 'Firemen's Memorial Sunday,' so that  
said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 72. Cities and towns may raise money to procure  
the writing and publication of their histories, to celebrate  
any centennial or other anniversary of the settlement or in-  
corporation of such city or town, and to publish the pro-

9 ceedings of any such celebration, to defray the expense of  
10 the observation of Memorial Day, Firemen's Memorial Sun-  
11 day and of Old Home Week, and a sum not exceeding five  
12 thousand (5000) dollars in any one town for erecting a  
13 suitable monument in memory of the soldiers who sacrificed  
14 their lives in the defence of their country in the war of  
15 eighteen hundred and sixty-one, and a reasonable sum to  
16 secure, grade and care for a lot appropriate for such monu-  
17 ment. They may also raise money to be expended for ex-  
18 terminating or controlling brown-tail and gypsy moths and  
19 other insect pests.'
