AN ACT to amend Section 72 of Chapter 4 of Revised Statutes of Maine relating to Firemen's Memorial Sunday.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section 72 of Chapter 4 of the Revised Stat-

- 2 utes is hereby amended by adding after the words, "Memo-
- 3 rial Day," the words 'Firemen's Memorial Sunday,' so that
- 4 said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 72. Cities and towns may raise money to procure

- 6 the writing and publication of their histories, to celebrate
- 7 any centennial or other anniversary of the settlement or in-
- 8 corporation of such city or town, and to publish the pro-

9 ceedings of any such celebration, to defray the expense of the observation of Memorial Day, Firemen's Memorial Sun11 day and of Old Home Week, and a sum not exceeding five thousand (5000) dollars in any one town for erecting a suitable monument in memory of the soldiers who sacrificed their lives in the defence of their country in the war of eighteen hundred and sixty-one, and a reasonable sum to secure, grade and care for a lot appropriate for such monument. They may also raise money to be expended for exterminating or controlling brown-tail and gypsy moths and other insect pests.'
