STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to Enlarge the Purposes of the New England Fish Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The New England Fish Company, a corporation exist2 ing under the general laws of the State of Maine, is here3 by authorized and empowered to engage in and carry
4 on, the following business in addition to that named in,
5 and authorized by, its certificate of organization, to wit:
6 all kinds of mercantile, manufacturing, mechanical, mining
7 and quarrying business; the carriage of passengers and
8 freight, or both, upon any waters where said corporation

9 may legally navigate; and also in places and states (other 10 than the State of Maine) where permissible under the laws 11 thereof, to engage in the construction and operation of rail- 12 roads, telegraph and telephone lines; the generating, selling 13 and distributing of water power, gas and electricity for 14 lighting, heating, manufacturing, mechanical, or other uses.
