STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Eastern Maine Railroad.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The rights, powers and privileges of the Eastern Maine
2 Railroad which were granted by chapter 188 of the private
3 and special laws of the state of Maine for the year 1911,
4 and extended and amended by chapter 86 of the private and
5 special laws of the state of Maine for the year 1913, are
6 hereby extended for two years additional, and the persons
7 named in said act and their associates and successors shall
8 have the rights, powers and privileges that were granted to
9 them by said act and amendment thereof, to be exercised
10 by them for the same purposes as specified in said act and
11 amendment thereof.

STATE OF MAINE.
