## STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of construction of road in the town of Moscow.

*Resolved*, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum 2 of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) for the year 1915 to aid 3 the town of Moscow in the construction of a road from the 4 residence of Mrs. Delia McLaughlin to the Maine Central 5 Railroad station at Dead Water, all in the Town of Mos-6 cow, provided said town of Moscow appropriates the like 7 sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) for the same pur-8 pose; both sums to be expended under the direction of the 9 State Highway Department. • -•

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This road will furnish a route whereby a village with a population of more than one hundred can obtain access to a market town. At present time village can be reached only by train, a distance of eight miles from Bingham, length of proposed road as laid out and approved by County Commissioners is about 2 I-9 miles.
