STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of repair of the River Road in Pleasant Ridge Plantation in the County of Somerset, in the part thereof known as the John Rowe Ledge.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) for the year 1915 3 to aid Pleasant Ridge Plantation in Somerset County in the 4 repair and alteration of that part of the River Road, so-5 called, in said plantation known as the John Rowe Ledge, 6 provided said Pleasant Ridge Plantation appropriates a like 7 sum of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000) for the same pur-8 pose; both sums to be expended under the direction of the 9 State Highway Department.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

This is an extremely dangerous section of road which is much frequented by automobiles from all parts of the state. During the summer season there is a stage line over this road to Carry Pond. Pleasant Ridge has a population of ninety-two, a valuation of only \$67,180, and is financially unable to bear the whole cost of this necessary improvement.
