*Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars to be expended
3 under the State Highway Commission for repairing the
4 county road leading through Brewer, Holden, and Ded-
5 ham to Ellsworth.*

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The county road leading through Brewer, Holden and Dedham to Ellsworth in many places is dangerous for any kind of travel, having many short, sharp curves, rocky narrow hills and many places with no proper drainage.
