STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT providing licenses for adjusters of fire losses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

No insurance company transacting fire insurance business 2 in this state shall permit any representative to adjust a loss 3 until such representative has been licensed in accordance 4 with the provisions of this act. The insurance commission-5 er may issue a license to any person to act as an adjuster 6 of losses by fire upon receipt of application in such form as 7 may be required by him and upon the payment of a fee of 8 \$5.00. Before issuing license to any adjuster the insurance 9 commissioner shall satisfy himself that the applicant is a

suitable person to act as an adjuster. The insurance commissioner may at any time after the granting of such license, for cause shown, and after a hearing, determine any person so licensed to be unsuitable to act as an adjuster and shall thereupon revoke such license and shall notify the adjuster of such revocation.
