STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT additional to Chapter 32 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by Chapter 206 of the Public Laws of 1913, relating to night hunting.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. It shall be unlawful to hunt, pursue, take, catch,
2 injure, kill or destroy any wild bird or wild animal in this
3 state at any time from one half hour after sunset until one
4 half hour before sunrise of the following morning.

It shall also be unlawful for any person to have in posses-6 sion any wild bird or wild animal, or part thereof, taken in 7 violation of any provision of this section.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any provision of this act shall 2 pay a fine of not less than ten dollars nor more than fifty 3 dollars and costs for each offense.
