STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND FIFTEEN

AN ACT to provide for the distribution of State School Funds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section one hundred and twenty-six of chapter
2 fifteen of the revised statutes of nineteen hundred and three
3 is hereby amended so that said section one hundred and
4 twenty-six, as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 126. This fund shall be distributed by the treasurer
6 of state on the first day of January, annually, to the several
7 cities, towns and plantations according to the aggregate at-
8 tendance of scholars at the elementary public schools there-
9 in, as the same shall appear from the official returns made

10 to the state superintendent of public schools for the pre-
11 ceding year.'

Sect. 2. Section three of chapter one hundred and sev-
2 enty-seven of the public laws of nineteen hundred and nine
3 is hereby amended so that said section three, as amended,
4 shall read as follows:

'Sect. 3. This fund shall be distributed by the treasurer
6 of state on the first day of January, annually, to the several
7 cities, towns and plantations according to the aggregate at-
8 tendance of scholars at the elementary public schools there-
9 in, as the same shall appear from the official returns made
10 to the state superintendent of public schools for the pre-
11 ceding year.'

Sect. 3. The aggregate attendance in any city, town or
2 plantation, shall be determined by computing the grand total
3 of the number of days and fractional parts thereof that the
4 total number of scholars may have been in attendance at
5 all the elementary public schools therein during said pre-
6 ceding year.

Sect. 4. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this
2 act are hereby repealed.
