AN ACT for the protection of travelers at grade crossings.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Steam railroads crossing highways or town ways at grade  
2 shall maintain at all such crossings, except such as are pro-  
3 tected by gates, an efficient electric bell or other automatic  
4 signal, capable of seasonably warning travelers on such high-  
5 ways or town ways of the approach of trains.
