STATE OF MAINE

RESOLVE, in favor of monuments in memory of Benedict Arnold's expedition through Maine to Quebec.

Resolved, That the sum of Five Hundred Dollars be and is hereby appropriated for the purpose of erecting four monuments in memory of Benedict Arnold's expedition through Maine to Quebec in the fall of 1775, said monuments to be located at points of landing and embarkation of the expedition along the Kennebec River in the city of Waterville and towns of Winslow and Fairfield.

The appropriation called for in the resolve to be paid to the Committee on Monuments, Sons of the American Revolution, Waterville Chapter 1, and to be expended in the year 1915 for the purpose named under the direction of this committee and the Governor of the State of Maine and Council.
